TASTING NOTE

An intense mulberry red appearance, with vibrant freshness. Aromas of leather, truffle oil and intense bitter cherry with touches of sweet strawberry aromas. Palate is classically dry with a tight tannin structure, although light in appearance there is an abundance of length and grip which will add to the ageing of 4-6 years.
