## TASTING NOTE

Bitter cherries, earthy notes, wild berries and cedar wood are leading aromatics in this wine. The tannin structure is tight and extremely well balanced and shows a good sense of elegance. The fine balance of this wine allows for early consumption as well as laying it down to age for 4-7 years. Compared to the 2010 vintage, the tannin structure is more velvety with stronger earthy notes and a higher acidity level.
