TASTING NOTE

This is the 6th vintage of our Elgin Pinot Noir. The wine's aromatics are lead by delicate wild and sour cherries, clean and elegant earthy notes which are complimented by a light touch of Burgundian French oak. The tannin structure is surprisingly well textured and extremely well balanced for this elegant wine and finishes well with a fresh natural acidity.

VINTAGE REVIEW

Good long winter, but late rains and cold delaying pruning. Great windless conditions experienced for flowering resulted in a high yield vintage. February temperatures were extremely hot pushing ripening and this made for a quick harvest. Highest recorded tonnages for Waterford Estate. Whites challenging but the red wines have impressed.
