TASTING NOTE

This is the 7th vintage of our Elgin Pinot Noir. A pale colour with floral, delicate wild cherry and elegant earthy aromas which are complimented by maturation in old Burgundian French oak. The tannin structure is surprisingly well textured and extremely well balanced for this elegant wine and finishes well with a fresh natural acidity.

VINTAGE REVIEW

Winter was cut a little short with temperatures rising quickly in August, the growing season remained warm and dry bringing the harvest dates slightly forward. Moderate to cool conditions during ripening resulted in wines with excellent preserved aromatics and flavours. Exceptional white and red wines from this vintage, true greats.
